Availability

NEW Offline Access using HMH Player

The *HMH Player* app version 3.0 is now available. This update integrates program content from *HMH Social Studies*, providing you with online and offline access to the eBook. Upon opening the app, users should select “*Ed: Your Friend in Learning*” from the drop-down menu and then enter their account login information.

Please note that not all functionality that is available in browser-based access to *Ed* is available within the *HMH Player* app.

Offline Access: The *HMH Player* app allows students to download individual eBook lessons to access content when offline. Annotations and eBook open-response questions are not currently available when offline.

Passcode for Offline Access: Users will be prompted to create a four-digit passcode when first accessing the *HMH Player* app with their *Ed* account, which will facilitate offline access.

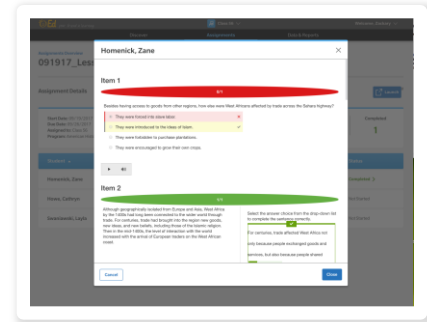


HMH Social Studies Update – October 2017

NEW Assessment Capabilities

A new assessment capability has been added for *HMH Social Studies*.

Viewing Completed Assessments: Teachers can view completed assessments from students by navigating to the Assessment Details page in the Assignments section, and selecting the “Completed” link in the status column. Correct items will have a **green highlight** and incorrect items will have a **red highlight**.



There is also a recent update to assessment scoring within *HMH Social Studies*.

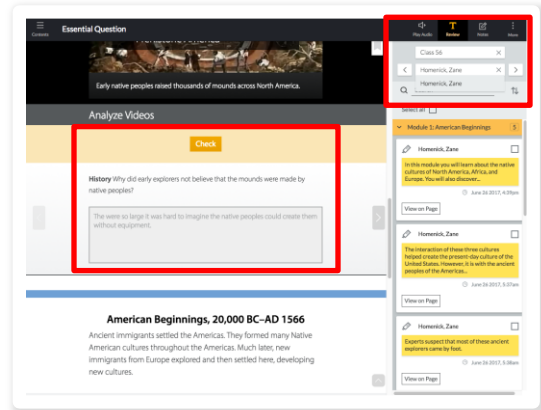
HMH Social Studies Assessments	Estimated Time
Provisional Scoring is now available within <i>Ed</i> , providing greater flexibility for teachers when manually scoring assessment items. All items within an assessment that can be automatically scored by the system will factor into reporting as soon as the student submits the completed assessment. Items that require manual scoring by the teacher can be complete as time allows and will factor into reporting once completed.	Available Now
Custom Assessments: The ability for teachers to add, remove and reorder assessment questions as well as the ability to create new assessments from an item back is not yet available. This enhancement is estimated for Spring 2018.	Spring 2018
Downloadable and editable assessments are in development for <i>HMH Social Studies</i> and will be made available on a rolling schedule from October 2017 – January 2018.	October 2017 – January 2018
Student Reporting: The ability for students to see how they scored on assessments is estimated to be available in Mid-November, 2017.	Mid-November, 2017



NEW eBook Functionality

There is an update to eBook functionality for *HMH Social Studies*.

Viewing Student eBook Responses: Teachers can launch the Student eBook from their own account and view student responses to questions. After opening the Student Edition, navigate to the page with the question, and then select the “T” **Teacher Review** icon in the upper right corner of the screen. By selecting the appropriate class and then the individual student, teachers can see student responses to each question.



NEW Rostering Capabilities

The *Ed* system was optimized to use standard rostering methods, such as Simple File Format, OneRoster, etc. There are two recent updates expanding manual rostering and classroom management capabilities for *HMH Social Studies*.
